HOW TO USE THE CATALOGUE

Like the catalogue of 1950, this supplement takes the form of a classified catalogue, that is, a catalogue in which the books are arranged by subjects following the order of some predetermined system of classification. Though the catalogue may seem unfamiliar at first sight and difficult to consult, the effort required to master the technique of using such a catalogue will soon be found to be amply repaid. In a classified library personal users have the great advantage of being able to choose from the shelves the volume they consider most suitable for their purpose from among a collection of books on the same aspect of the subject in which they are interested. Obviously, if borrowers from a library which is operative for most only through the medium of the post are to enjoy this same advantage, the catalogue must perform the function of shelf classification and bring together like books on like subjects. In some respects the postal user of a classified catalogue listing every unit of the stock is better off than the personal user of the library whose choice is virtually limited to the books available at the time of his visit. Though books or parts of books can be listed at several points in the catalogue, books may stand at only one point on the shelves, and some part of their value is always in danger of being overlooked. The catalogue is in three parts - the main classified list, the author index, and the subject index. The indexes are the key to the main classified list.

To understand the symbols under which the books are listed, it is necessary to bear in mind that these combinations of letters and figures are but a small part of a much larger scheme covering the whole field of knowledge. It would serve no useful purpose to outline this complete system of book classification here, but the scheme is the one which was first applied to the huge collections of the Library of Congress in Washington, and which has been adopted throughout the Edinburgh Public Libraries system. In this scheme, which is arranged first by letters and then by numbers, the vast majority of the Moir Library books come within main class S - Agriculture and sub-class SF - Animal Culture. The few entries which do not have an SF classification are arranged by the numbers they would have had in the general Library of Congress scheme.

The real identifying number of a book is its accession number (e.g. [ML 1226]) given in brackets after the title of each book in the catalogue and this number should be quoted in addition to the class mark in asking for books. Thus the catalogue proper must always be consulted as the indexes do not note such details.

Therefore, if you want a book and know the name of the AUTHOR consult the AUTHOR INDEX under the known name and refer to the class mark shown against the short title of the book you require. When this is done you will find not only the book you seek but listed alongside it whatever other books the library possesses on the same topic. If author is unknown or

unimportant and you want to find out what is to be got on a given SUBJECT consult the SUBJECT INDEX which will guide you from the name of the subject to its class mark and thereby to the place in the catalogue where all such books are listed.

To sum up. Consult either the Author or Subject Index first to obtain the class mark (subject mark) of the book you require, locate this in the main body of the catalogue and quote both the class mark of the book and the accession number - the number in square brackets after the title. Give an alternative choice or list of choices whenever possible. If the latest edition of any book is in use an earlier edition will be sent unless specified otherwise. When any request cannot be satisfied on account of a book being on loan at the time of application, the borrower's name will be added to the waiting list and the book sent when available.
