Rules and Additional Guidance

1. Entrants need to be under 16 years of age on Friday the 15th of October 2021.
2. Only signed submissions can be accepted into the competition. Entrants aged under 16 must have forms signed by a parent or legal guardian. By signing the form, you agree that the person taking the photograph has given their permission for its use. Any photographs of children must include written permission from a parent or legal guardian of every child featured.
3. Should the Royal Highland Show be unable to proceed in 2022, then the photographs will be displayed at the next Royal Highland Show, or another event as agreed by the Trustees of the SBA.
4. The competition will be judged by the SBA's Young Beekeeper's Group and results agreed by the SBA Trustees. Their decision will be final.
5. Entries should be submitted by Friday the 15th of October at 6pm either by email to Bron Wright on youngbeekeepers@scottishbeekeepers.org.uk or by post to Bron Wright, 20 Lennox Row, Edinburgh, EH5 3JW
6. The winners will be notified in December 2021 and announced in the January 2022 Scottish Beekeeper magazine.
7. Photos should be A4 size or under, they can be in any colour, and if emailed should be in a jpg, png, gif, tiff or pdf file format. Please do not make the photos too small as they will need to be printed for display at the Royal Highland Show.
8. Please use the attached form to submit your details and the sentences relating to your photographs. An example is given below as guidance.
9. Remember the idea is to make the display interesting to the visiting public. Entrants should give thought to the variety of things they see and do in beekeeping (we don't really want 3 photographs of entrants standing beside their hives) so think what you see in the hive, forage, processing products of the hive, bee anatomy, making equipment etc. – there really are so many things involved in beekeeping.
