




Calligram Competition

What Do You Need to Do?

- Choose an image of a worker honey bee (see the following pages for some options)
- Draw out or trace your outline as lightly as possible
- Decide what type of **fonts**, **colours** and **styles** you want to use
- Use a pencil to fill the relevant section of the honey bee worker with the appropriate word e.g., if you're trying to write a word in the top wing you could write **forewing**
- Repeat this process until the entire bee is complete with the relevant words in the correct part. Remember to double check your bee anatomy references
- Next, rub out any outlines and go over your pencil in whatever colours and thickness you like

- Please include your name, school, year (e.g., S1) and contact details, and if you are under 16, please include the contact details and a letter of permission to enter and display your Calligram from your parent/legal guardian.
- Please ensure your Calligram is A4 size or under, is legible, anatomically correct and can be reproduced easily (for printing in the magazine). And if emailing please use the following file formats: jpeg, png, tiff, gif or pdf. Save the electronic Calligram file with 'YourName'.

Rules and Additional Guidance

1. Entrants need to be in years S1 to S6 on Monday the 13th of September 2021.
2. Only signed submissions can be accepted into the competition. Entrants aged under 16 must have permissions signed by a parent or legal guardian.
3. You agree that the person creating the Calligram has given their permission for its use.
4. The competition will be judged by the SBA's Young Beekeepers Group and results agreed by the SBA Trustees. Their decision will be final.
5. Entries should be submitted by Monday the 13th of September either by email to Bron Wright on youngbeekeepers@scottishbeekeepers.org.uk or by post to Bron Wright, 20 Lennox Row, Edinburgh, EH5 3JW
6. The winners will be notified in November 2021 and announced in the December 2021 Scottish Beekeeper magazine.
7. Calligrams should be A4 size or under, they can be in any colour, and if emailed should be in a jpg, png, gif, tiff or pdf file format. Please do not make the Calligrams too small as they will need to be printed for display.
